






# Algorithmic Mapping POSIX ID S

# Slide Styles and Formatting

- Avoid deeply nested bullets and lots of text content in your slides
- There are nested bullets
  - But try to use them with care
    - Since that makes your slides very
      - Hard to read
        - Even though the sub-sub-sub-bullets
          - Are the same size, its still silly to have too many bullets.



## Show me the source!

#### If you want to have code examples, do this:

```
foreach code_snippet in slides {
    write_some_code();
    set font_face("Source Code Pro", "16pt");
    set font_color("white");
    set line_spacing("single");
    /* use promote/demote arrows for indentation */
}
```

If you wish to show more, switch to a text editor instead of the slides.



# **Colors and formatting**

- If you want to hilight something, select a bit of text, and set the font color to orange close to the logo color – on Fedora it seems like "Red Hat 3" color is close.
- Try to avoid **bold**, *italic* and <u>underline</u> they are distracting and make your slides hard to read.
